What happens where?

Module 1: From Idea to Audience (European Focus)

Module 1 takes you through each stage of the film value chain from a European film industry perspective, including development, financing and packaging to production, marketing, sales, distribution and home entertainment. You



will hear first hand from top executives working in all these areas. Where: London When: June 2019

Module 2: Getting Under the Hood of Hollywood

Module 2 takes you to the heart of the US film industry, and covers both the studio and independent system. You will hear from experienced execs from across the value chain and experience at first hand the strategic and business-like approach of professionals working in Hollywood. There will be sessions that are specific to the US, such as a session with a talent agency, a breakfast with a panel of managers, and a session on the unions and guilds.

Module 3 – Business & Personal Development

Module 3 is focused on business development and personal growth. During the week you will hear case studies from executives who have built, grown and sold successful film businesses. Some of the module is dedicated to professional development, with sessions on conflict management, negotiation and presentation skills. Where: London When: November 2019



Module 4 – Acess to Projects

This is the sponsors' opportunity to have early access to projects such as ROOM, LION, LEISURE SEEKER, GANGS OF LONDON - all of which began as participant project pitches on Inside Pictures.

Participants pitch their projects to a panel of top-level film executives from around Europe, and receive live feedback. At the Graduation Reception, participants are presented with a certificate documenting their successful completion of the course.

Meet the Alumni Reception in Cannes: Taking place during the film industry's most prestigious film festival and market, this is when we introduce the year's cohort of participants to the Inside Pictures network.(*May 2019*)

Industry Networking Drinks in London's film hub, Soho. A more intimate opportunity to bring participants, alumni, speakers and industry guests together to mark the start of the programme. (June 2019)

LA Industry Mixer Drinks: taking place during module 2, guests include representatives from the most influencial and innovative companies working in the US indie and studio space. (*September 2019*)

Meet Your IP Buddy: a formal event at which the current cohort meet the mentor chosen for them from amongst the entire IP network. A sponsor of this event would potentially have a direct approach to guests, and would be supporting a core belief of the organisation, which is to share knowledge, expertise and ideas.
