What happens where?

Module 1 - From Idea to Audience 9-14 June, London

Will take you through each stage of the film and TV value chain from a European film industry perspective, including considerations in development, the commissioning process, financing and packaging to production, marketing, sales and distribution. Participants will hear first-hand from top executives working in all these areas and will have the opportunity to hear about current trends, to develop a better understanding of audiences and consumers

Module 2 - Getting Under the Hood of Hollywood 15-20 Sept, Los Angeles

Takes you to the heart of the US industry and covers both the studio and independent system. Participants will hear from experienced execs from across the value chain and experience at first hand the strategic and business-like approach of professionals working in Hollywood.

Module 3 – Business & Personal Development 18-22 Nov, London

Is all about your own professional and business development and personal growth. During this final week participants will take part in sessions on conflict management, negotiation and presentation skills. They will have the opportunity to give consideration to their own business plans.

Module 4 - Participant Graduation 8-9 Jan 2025, London

The exact details of the event are to be determined, but will include networking opportunities for current participants and previous alumni.

Fees

There are several levels of fee depending on your circumstances:

UK Freelance: £6,500

This rate is for individuals who are personallypaying their fee for themselves, ie are not paying the fee through a company.

UK Corporate: £8,000

This rate is for individuals who are receivingfinancial support from their company to pay for their fee, either in part or wholly. We would anticipate anyone who is not a sole-trader, who is in receipt of a regular salary, and / or who is paying the fee through their company, to opt for this level.

International Freelance: £8,000

This rate is for non-UK nationalswho are paying for their paying their fee for themselves, ie are not paying the fee through a company.

International Corporate: £9,500

This rate is for non-UK nationals who are receiving financial support from their company to pay for their fee, either in part or wholly. We would anticipate anyone who is not a sole-trader, who is in receipt of a regular salary, and / or who is paying the fee through their company, to opt for this level.

Note: EU nationals who have been granted settled or pre-settled status under the EU settlement scheme may be eligible for "UK Fees", subject to meeting the residency requirements. (You need to be an ordinarily resident in the UK or EEA for 3 years prior to the start of your course).
